How is climate change affecting the UK and Ireland in 2024?

Darren Clarke, professor in climate and environmental change at Dublin City University, writes in the times newspaper (June 2024) “the impact of climate change has already become apparent, even at just 1.2 degrees warmer than pre-industrial average temperatures”.



All major cities in Ireland are in coastal locations subject to tides, any significant rise in sea levels will have major economic, social, and environmental impacts. Rising sea levels around Ireland would result in increased coastal erosion, flooding and damage to properties and infrastructure.

Ireland must invest in structural and behavioral change to enable the transition to a climate neutral, climate-resilient country. These changes include the rapid decarbonization of energy and transport and the adoption of sustainable food production, management, and consumption systems.
