“A little step will make many miles away”



Planting trees is one solution to reducing the heat wave. More and more the people have come to realize the importance of planting trees.

In August the best moment of the year where we get rain, the community of Ndongol with the help of a solidarity project fund from the Australian province, organized and distributed 810 trees to 46 groups and individuals of different villages.



In spite of the difficulties such as the dry heat and the animals in growing up the trees, it didn't discourage people from planting as they came forward to ask for trees. This has given a lot of encouragement for the sisters to organize this undertaking each year. We hope to make a better place for the next generation.
