Good news from India Centre Province:



The **Goaltuli** community (INC) took the initiative to plant 25 different kinds of tree plants in our own land recently. The sisters have cultivated some vegetables for daily use such as ladyfingers, yam, chilly, bitter gourd, beans, etc. Our land is a very low land and during the rainy season, the grass grows very fast and thick. Therefore very often we have to cut or pull out the grass and weeds.



We also take care of our flower garden at both the house and school. Sisters take care of them with much love, care and interest.
